

Non-Repayable, Non-Dilutive Government Grants

In Canada the Provincial and Federal Governments incent organizations to support the growth of the economy through non-repayable, non-dilutive Government Grants to assist in the funding of new projects and initiatives. Typically the number of Grants Programs available in Canada are in the hundreds. Most organizations have an internal funding strategy to fund new projects and initiatives but simply do not have the resources, time, personnel, or expertise in-house dedicated to finding available grant options and how to apply for them.

Government Grant Programs can be very lucrative:

- » Range from 20% to 80% reimbursement of your expenditures.
- » Cover periods of time ranging from 1 year to several years.

Government Funding Programs usually support the following:

- » Expansion, scalability, capital projects. Can range from \$100K to several \$Million.
- » Location or relocation to a particular province or area.
- » Research and Development projects. Can be more inclusive and generous than SR&ED Claims.
- » Green initiatives and sustainability efforts.
- » Export Marketing. Annual Programs for up to 50% of \$100,000.
- » Hiring Incentives. Can range from \$5K to \$25K per new employee.
- » Training incentives. For 3rd party training expenditures.
- » Incentives for Indigenous, Women, or Minority owned organizations.

Government Funding Programs generally list the following as application prerequisites:


- » Organization requirements such as size, number of employees, annual revenues, revenue growth, profitability, number of years in business, ownership, location.
- » Timing and documentation requirements.
- » Documentation to prove that the projects and initiatives are aligned to the Program incentives.
- » Applicant ability to fund the portion of the project not covered by the Grant.
- » Reimbursements for spending for expenditures after the Grant
